- Ill is definitely in the 3rd or 4th category. I've read the regs, but ILL doesn't answer the phone or return messages.
- SC and FLA seem to be more accepting of ABET-TAC. It's not easy, but the door is opening and there have been successful ABET-TAC candidates..
- Utah, ahhh... Utah. ABET-TAC can take the FE but not the PE in this state
- The MS degree can reset the required period of documented experience to ABET-EAC rules in some/most states.
