

OHIO CONTRACTOR'S ASSOCIATION – TOLEDO CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP

B.S. / B.A. Degree Programs

The Ohio Contractor's Association is "the voice" of the heavy and highway industry in Ohio. Its members profit from such benefits as political representation, safety programs, contract interpretation, and education/training programs. The Ohio Contractor's Association – Toledo Chapter Scholarship is a one-year scholarship awarded annually to a student who has demonstrated an interest in the heavy and highway construction industry and has an interest in staying in northwest Ohio upon graduation.

ELIGIBILITY

1. The student must be a citizen of the United States and be a second or third year student in a Bachelor of Science degree program in Civil Engineering, Construction Technology, Construction Management or a related area at the time of submitting this scholarship application and receiving the award.
2. The student must present a financial need to OCA.
3. Preference is to be given to Ohio residents and to those students who have shown an interest in the northwest Ohio heavy/highway construction industry.
4. All sections of the application form packet must be completed and returned to the Ohio Contractor's Association by October 2, 2009. The presentation will occur October 21, 2009 during the Toledo Chapter monthly dinner meeting. Incomplete application packets will not be considered.

CRITERIA

1. Selection of scholarship winners will be based upon the submission of a fully completed application.
2. The students must have two College/University Recommendation Forms (enclosed) completed by professors/instructors and returned to OCA by October 2, 2009.
3. The students should provide the names of other scholarships or grants applied for and the status of their award.
4. Students are encouraged (but not required) to include a recommendation from an OCA member company or individual.
5. There should be a demonstrated intent to remain in northwest Ohio after graduation, and seek permanent employment with an OCA member company.
6. The applicant must show excellence in scholastic ability.
7. Student participation in extra circular activities should be provided for consideration.
8. An official college/university transcript shall be sent with this application (student copies of transcripts will not be accepted).
9. All applicants must be willing to appear before the OCA Education Committee in Toledo if requested.
10. Funds will be made available for the 2009/2010 academic year.
